



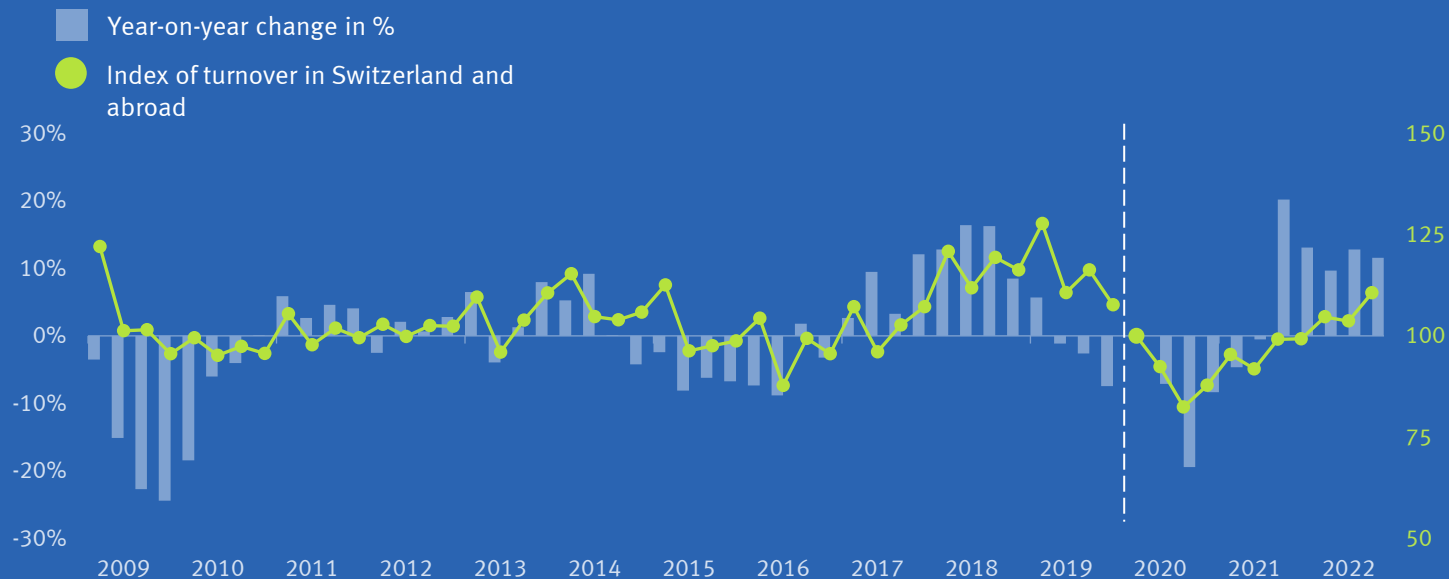

Swissmem quarterly statistics (Q4/2019=100)*



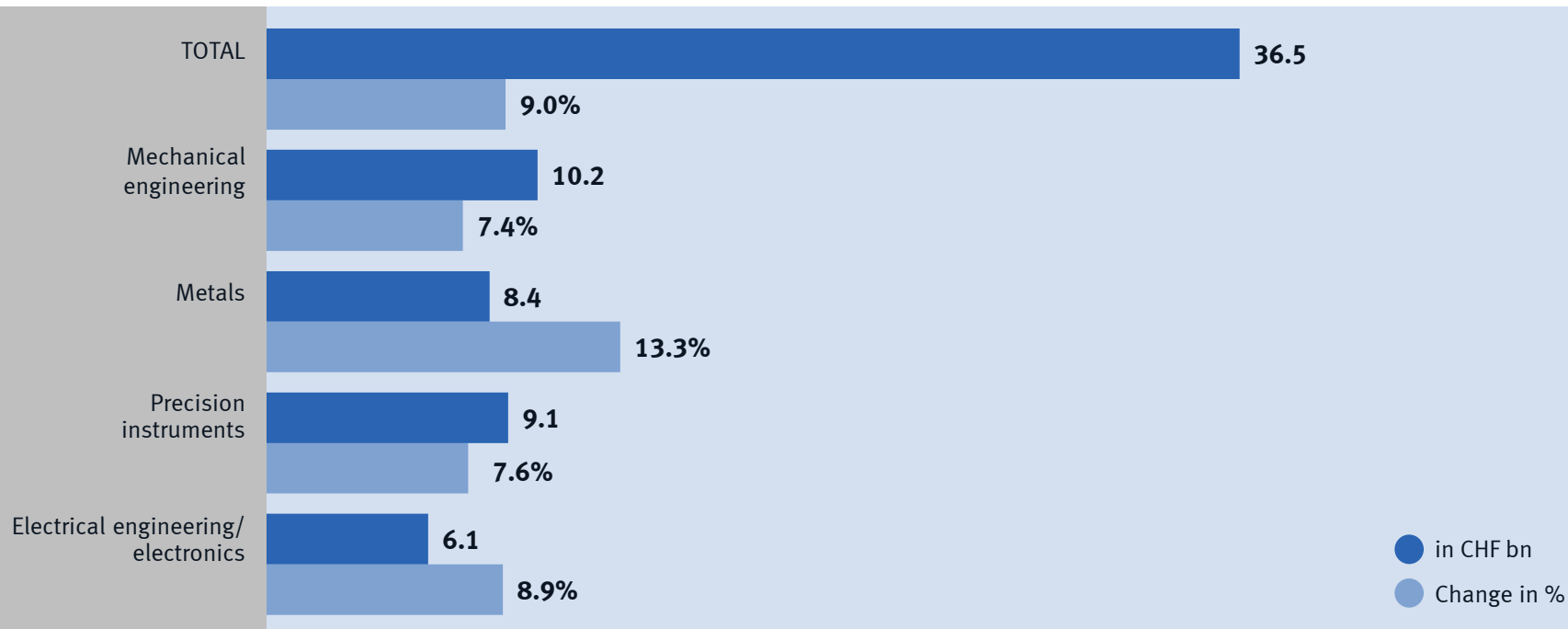

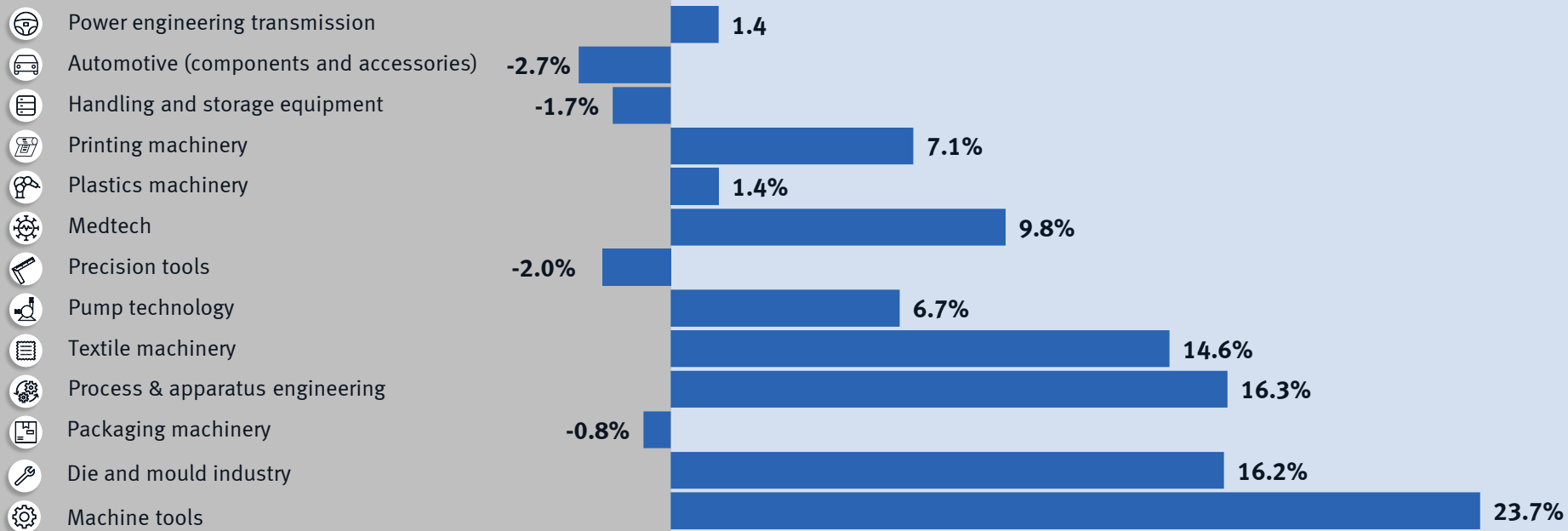
Exports of the MEM industries Jan. to June 2022

By selected subsectors, change compared with previous year

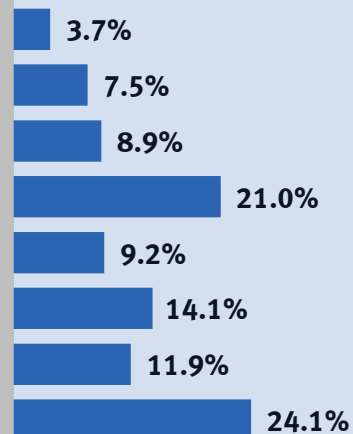

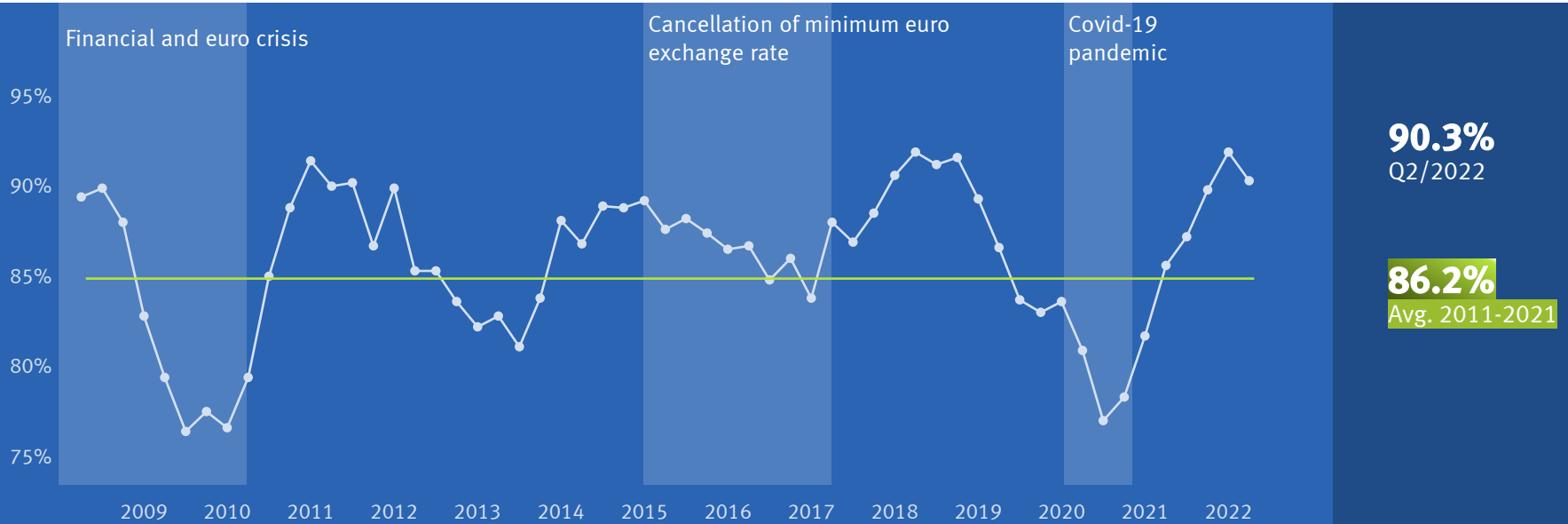

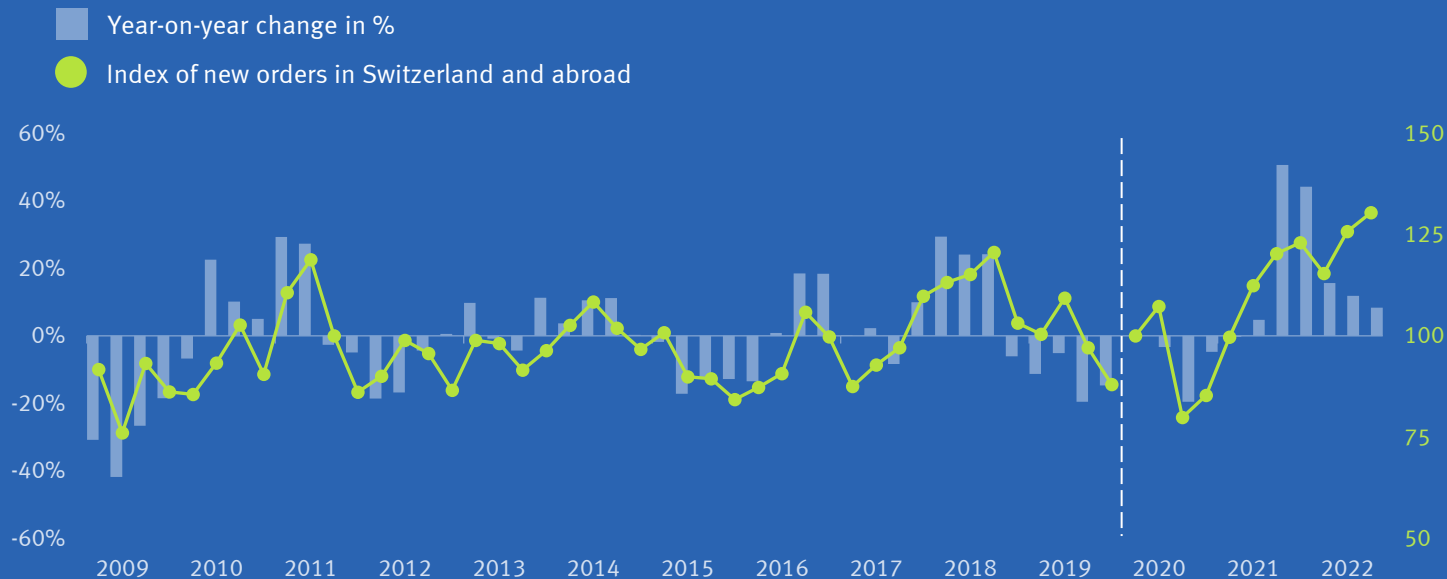
